Aim	<p>The aim of the course is to prepare Civilian and Military Staff Officers to serve within a UN Integrated Mission Headquarters. Special emphasis will be on the responsibilities, tasks and challenges on the U9 Staff Functional Area.</p> <p>The course, will allow the student to deploy and assume CIMIC Staff duties within United Nations Peacekeeping Operation (UNPKO) Formations and Force Headquarters.</p>
Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Structure of UNPKO and UN Integrated Mission.• UN U9 Responsibilities and Staff Processes.• Role of International Organisations and Non-Governmental Organisations in international or peace support operations and military relations with civil organisations.• Interpretation of the Civil-Military environment within a UNPKO in order to identify common interests and the fields of interaction.• Contrasting CIVMIL implications in regards to the planning process and the evaluation of the impacts on the CIVMIL environment.• Compiling CIVMIL inputs following staff procedures and supporting the staff synchronization process.• Contribution to the Pan Mission Information Management and Operational Picture.• Establishment of a Pan Mission Liaison Matrix in order to utilize contacts and key leaders identified.• Generation and assessment of reports and orders.• Develop an awareness of 'crosscutting' issues within a UNPKO.• Advise and represent military staff on various civil/local/cultural aspects in order to raise cultural/situational awareness• Generation of CIVMIL training and education requirements and plans for UNPKO Force Components.
Assessment	<p>There will be no written examinations at the end of the course.</p>
Certificate	<p>The NORDEFECO DIPLOMA will be issued.</p>
Duration	<p>1 week of 5 working days (Monday to Friday lunch time) with evening activities. Arrival to Nymindgab Barracks no later than 2200hrs on Sunday.</p>
Training Audience	<p>Military personnel NATO Grade OR7 - OF4 and civilian equivalents assigned for or potential for employment in CIMIC duties as part of UNPKO formations and headquarters or agencies in international or peace support operations.</p>

Conditions for admission (Pre-requisites)	<p>The course is conducted in English. Interpreters are not available.</p> <p>Language proficiency: listening – good / 3 (NATO code) speaking – good / 3 (NATO code) reading – good / 3 (NATO code) writing – fair / 2 (NATO code)</p> <p>Documented (copy of Course Certificate is required) foundation CIMIC Course.</p> <p>For military students with no CIMIC experience or training it is mandatory to successfully complete the United Nations Civil-Military Coordination ADL-course provided by the Peace Operations Training Institute (POTI) prior to the NORDEFECO UN Civil Military Cooperation Staff Officers Course.</p> <p>You will find the course info via this link: http://www.peaceopstraining.org/courses/un-civil-military-coordination-un-cimic/</p> <p>If you are a new student at POTI you have to sign up.</p>
Number of students	<p>A maximum of 20 students.</p> <p>NORDEFECO: By previous agreement.</p> <p>Other countries: On a space available basis or by agreement.</p> <p>Civil organizations/personnel are encouraged to participate.</p>
